Dear Madam:

I was so entirely at a loss to get in touch with some of the workers in Holland that I took what seemed to me the one feasible plan to do so. I am glad to say that it has resulted in bringing letters from yourself and one other lady, and I hasten to explain that it has been our desire in the Congress to have it representative of the work of women in all classes and all lines of work. Any failure on our part to do so has not been the result of intention but of the shortness of time given us for the preparations and the impossibility of doing more work with the amount of money and the assistants which we have.

I will see that your greeting from Holland is read at the Congress.

My own work in connection with women's organizations does not end with this Woman's Congress and I shall be more than delighted if you will send me the names of woman in Holland who are working for woman's advancement in any and all lines. Associations with which I am connected are often issuing documents which would probably be of interest to such advanced women and I shall be glad to have their names on my list.
